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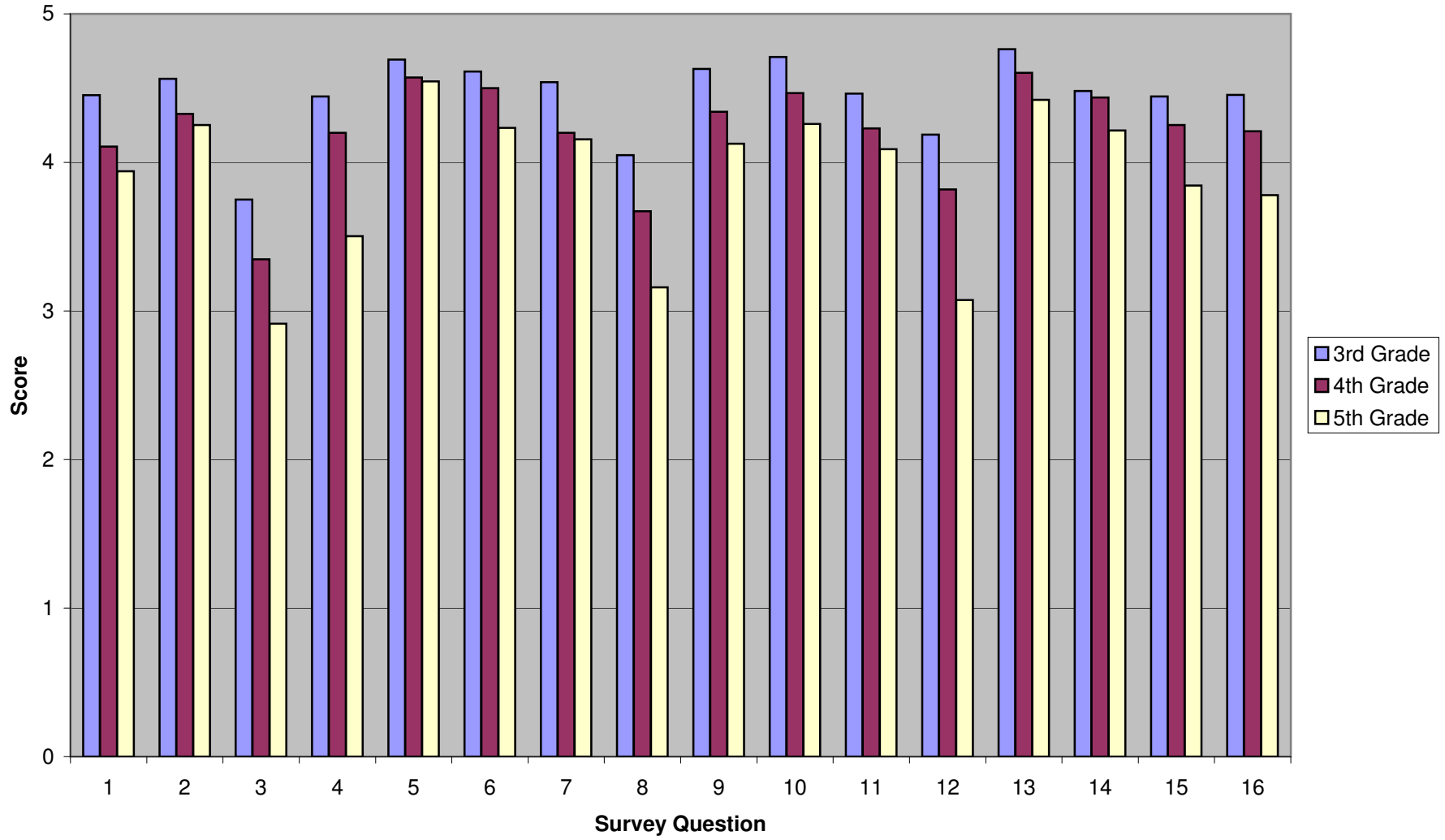

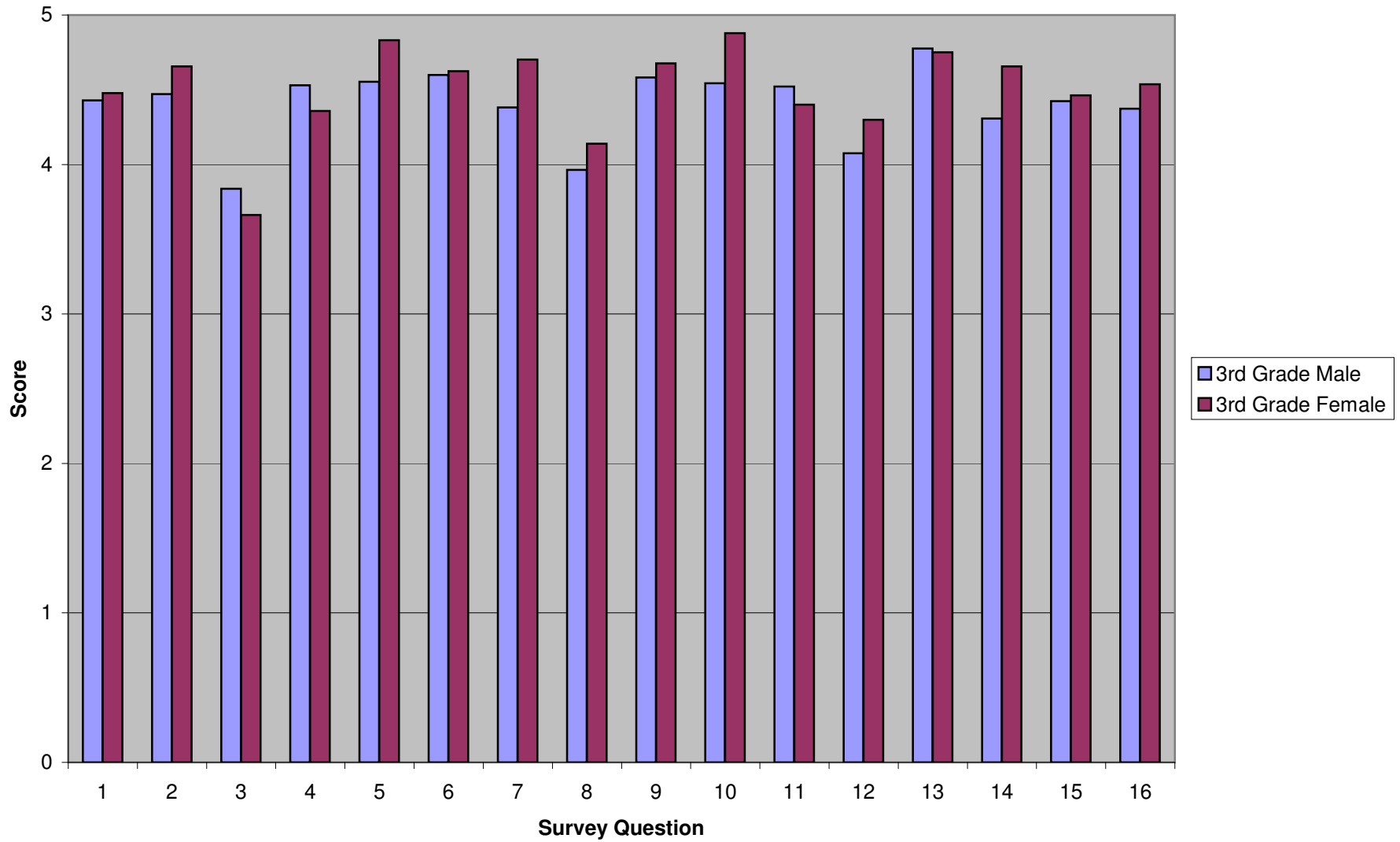

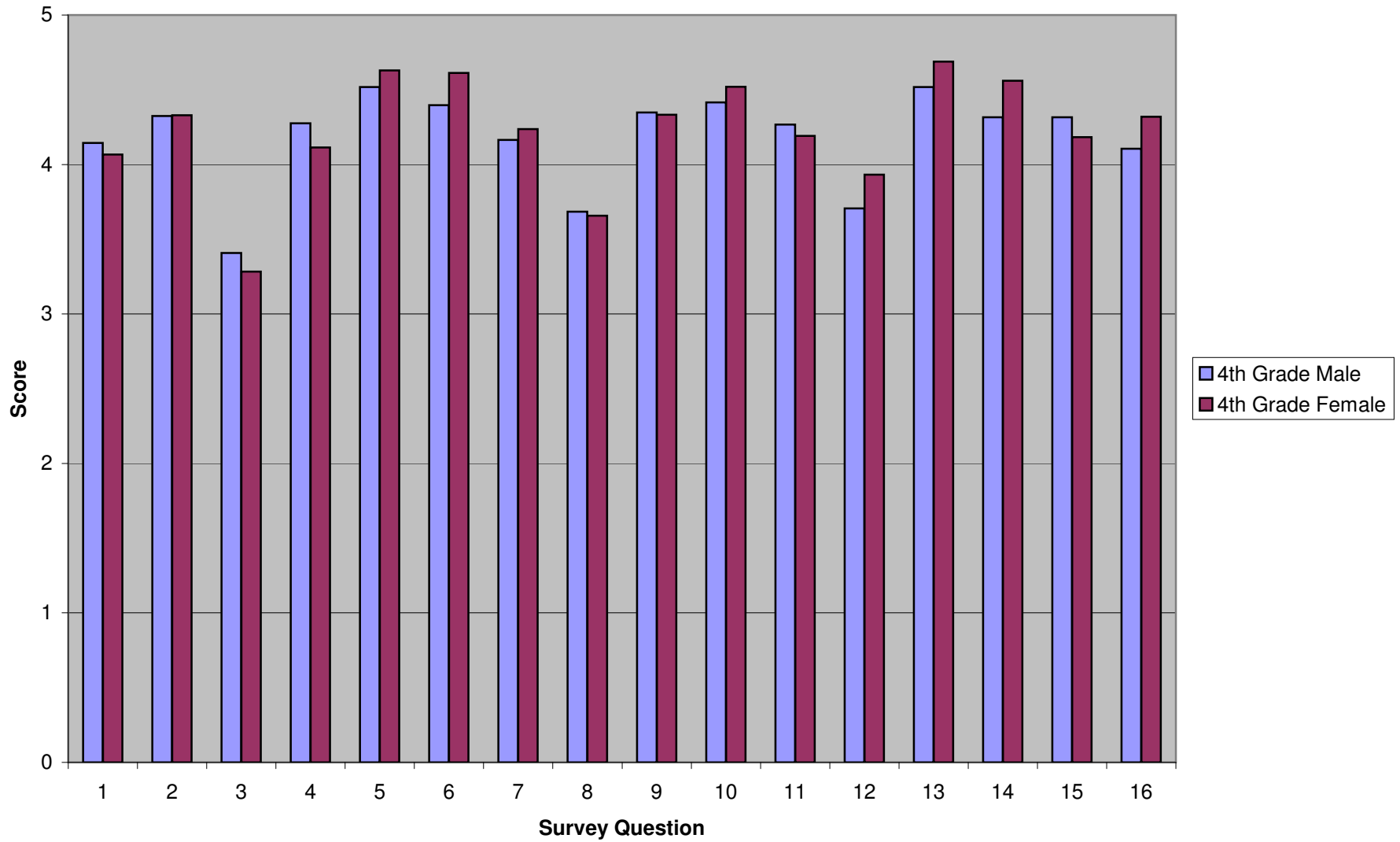
Citizenship Survey Grades 3-5 Total



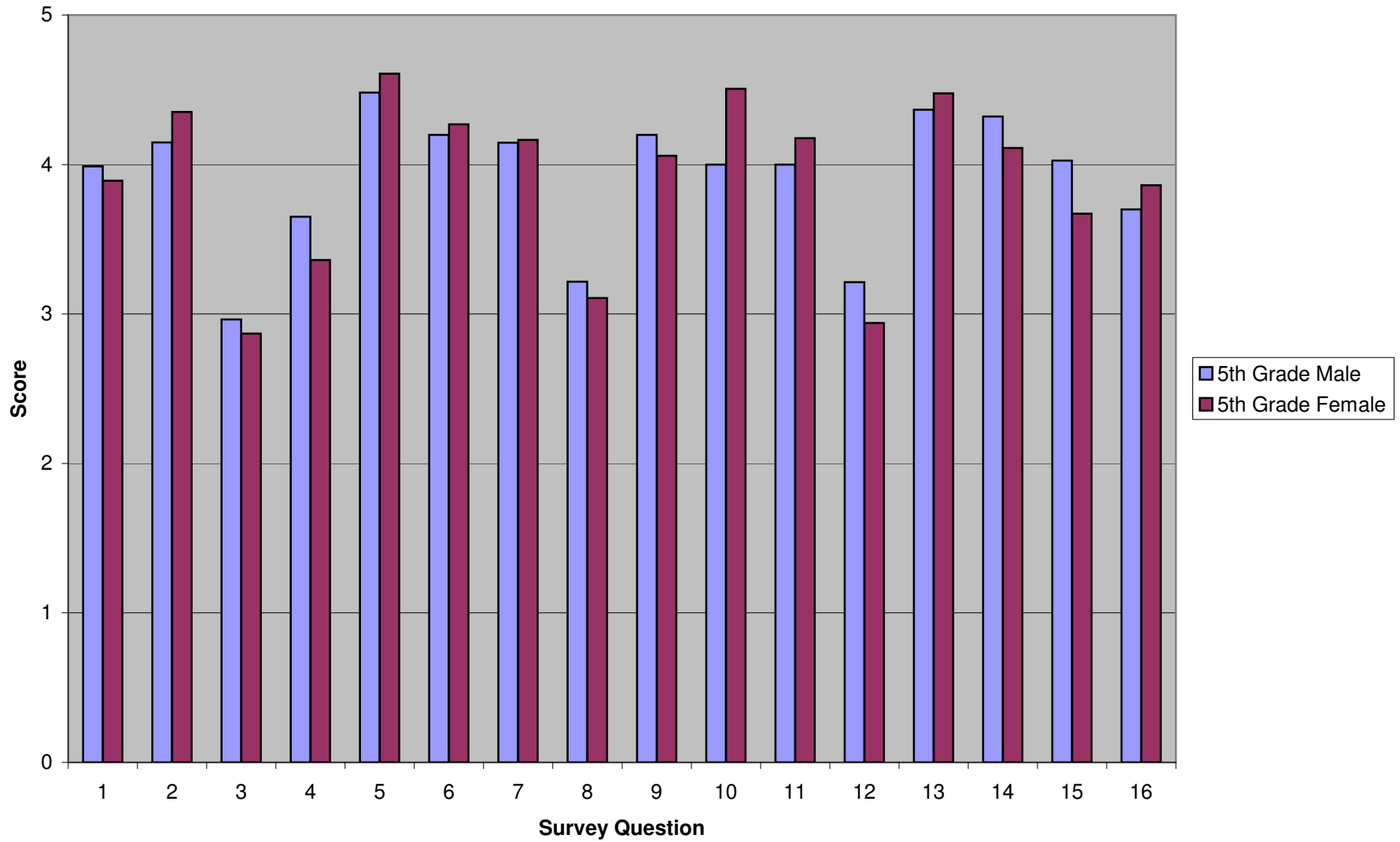
3rd Grade Citizenship Survey Male vs Female

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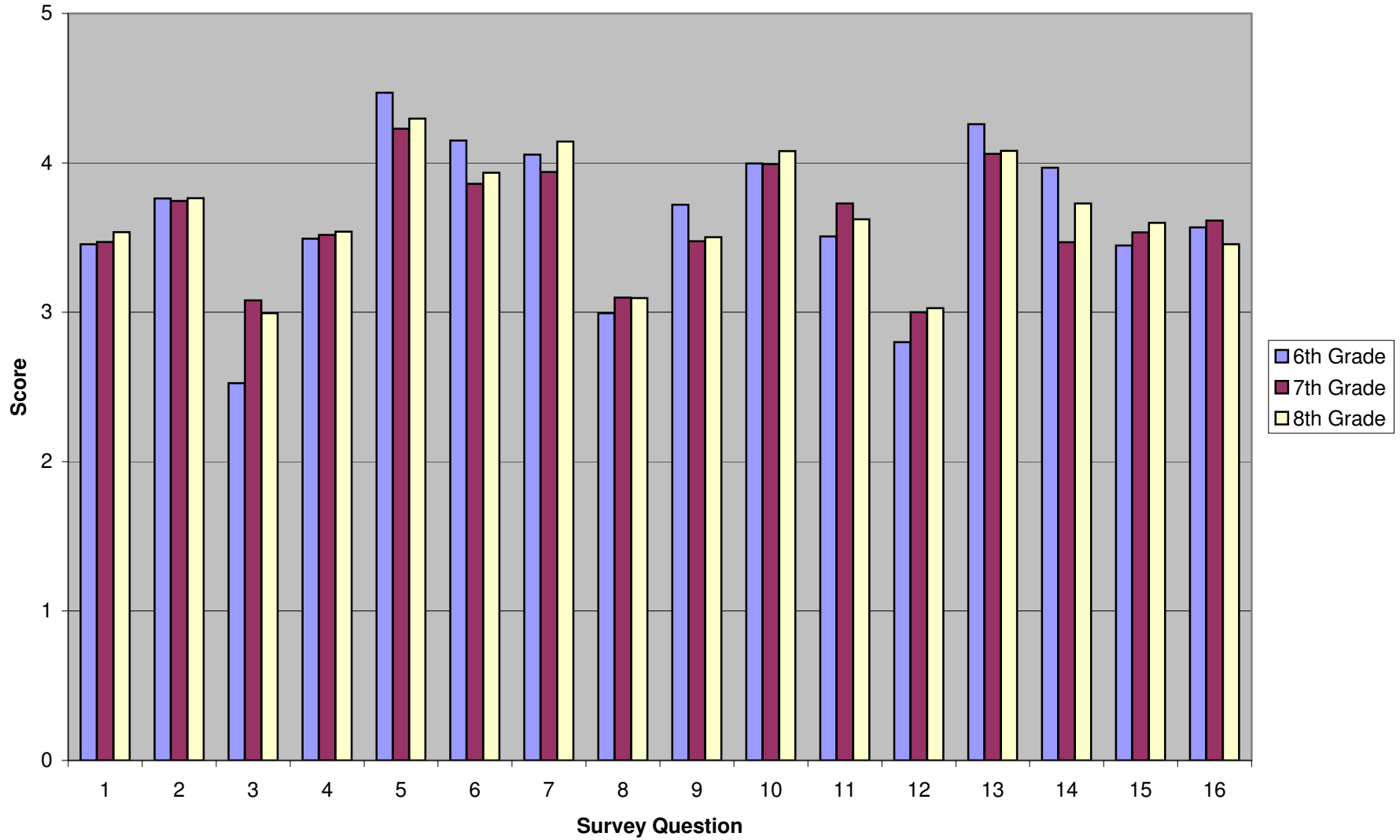

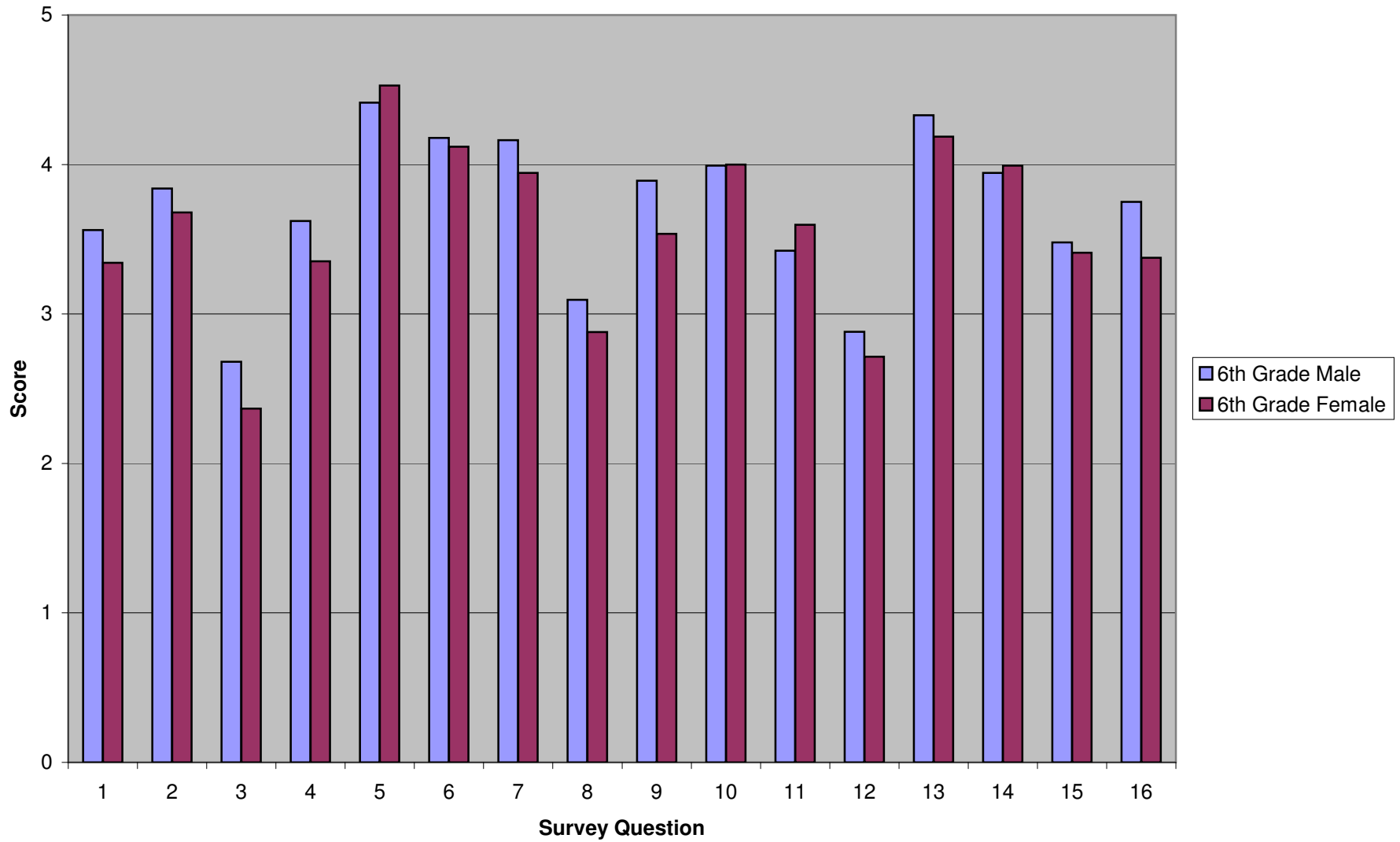

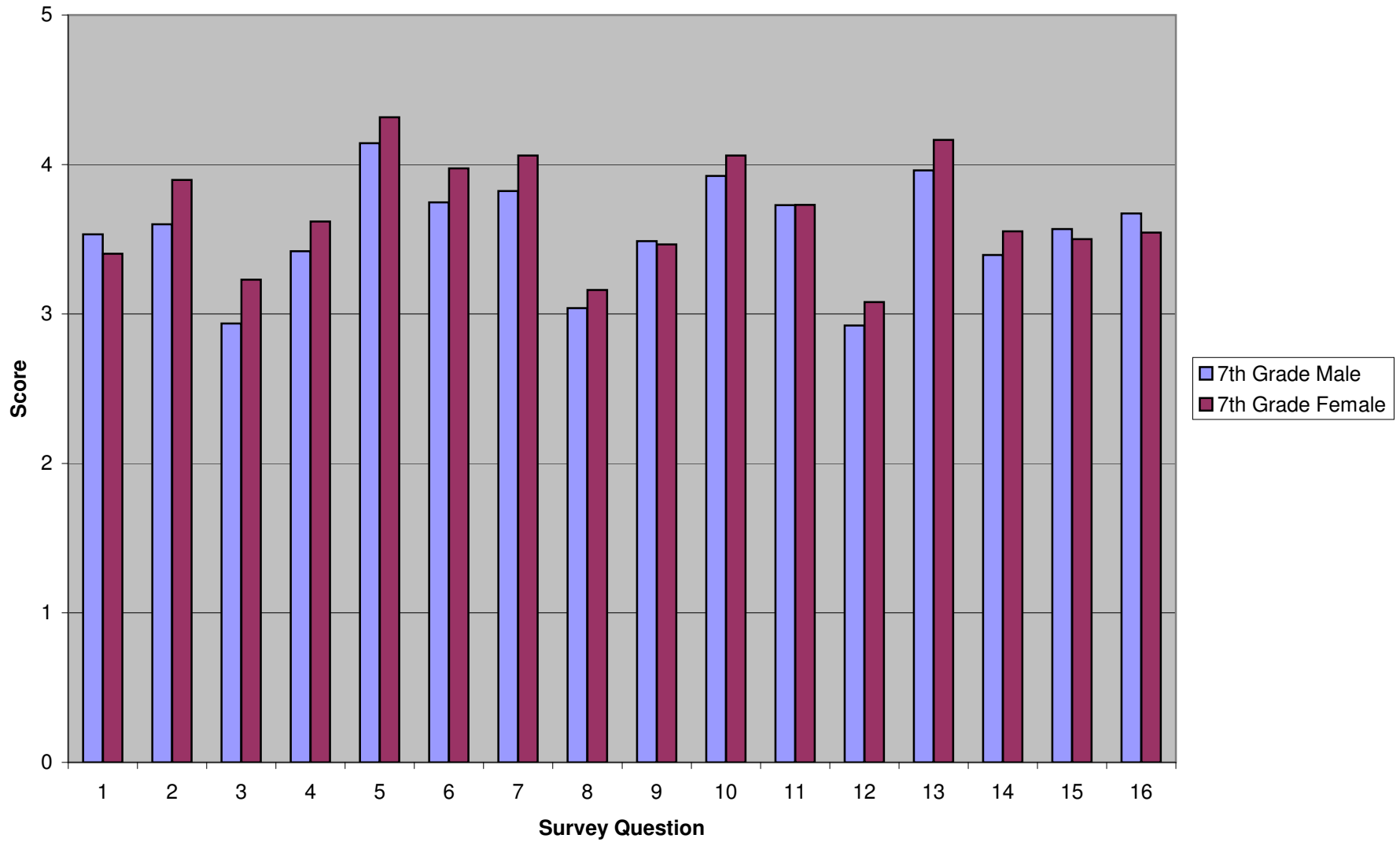
Citizenship Survey Middle School Total



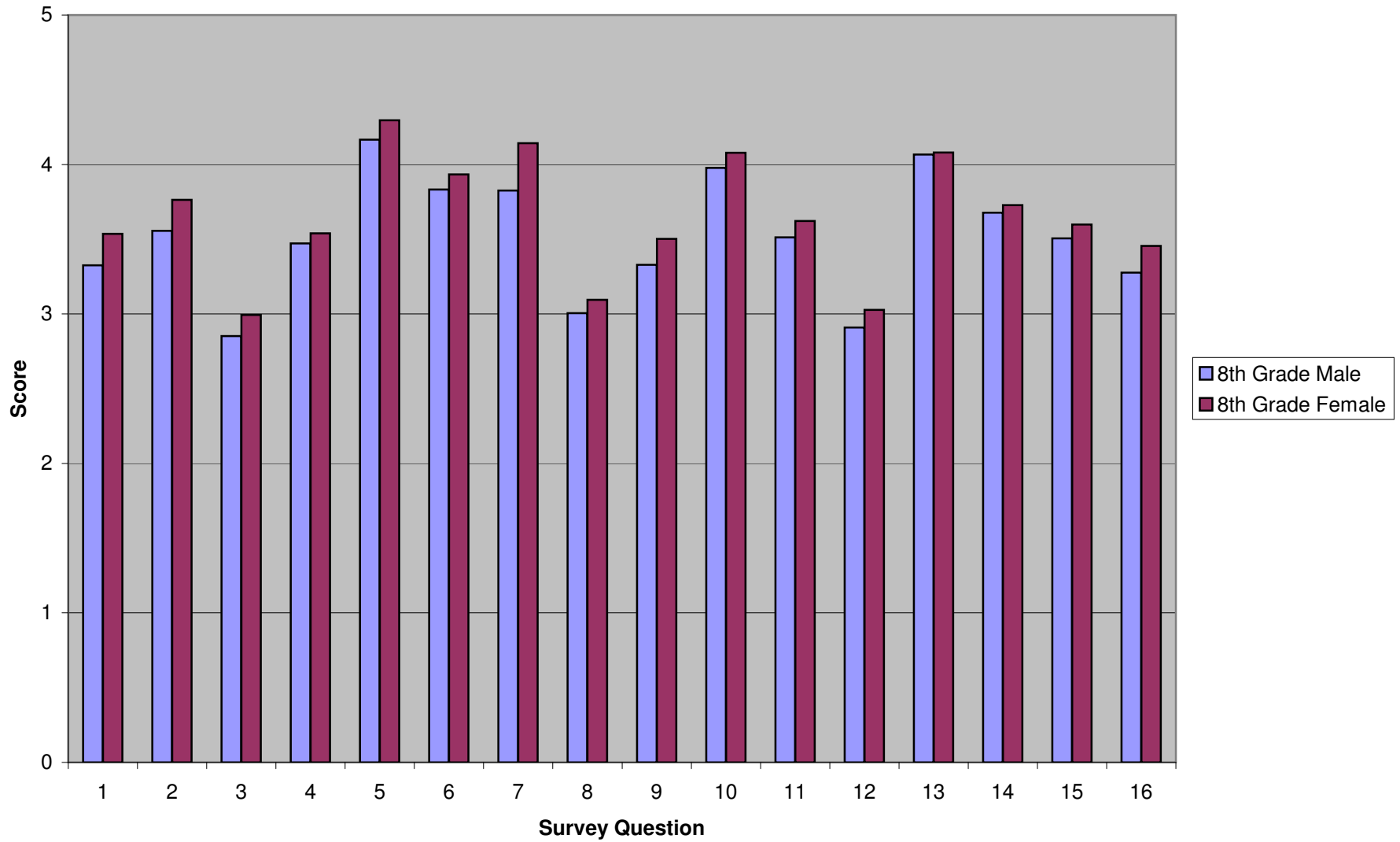
6th Grade Citizenship Results by Gender

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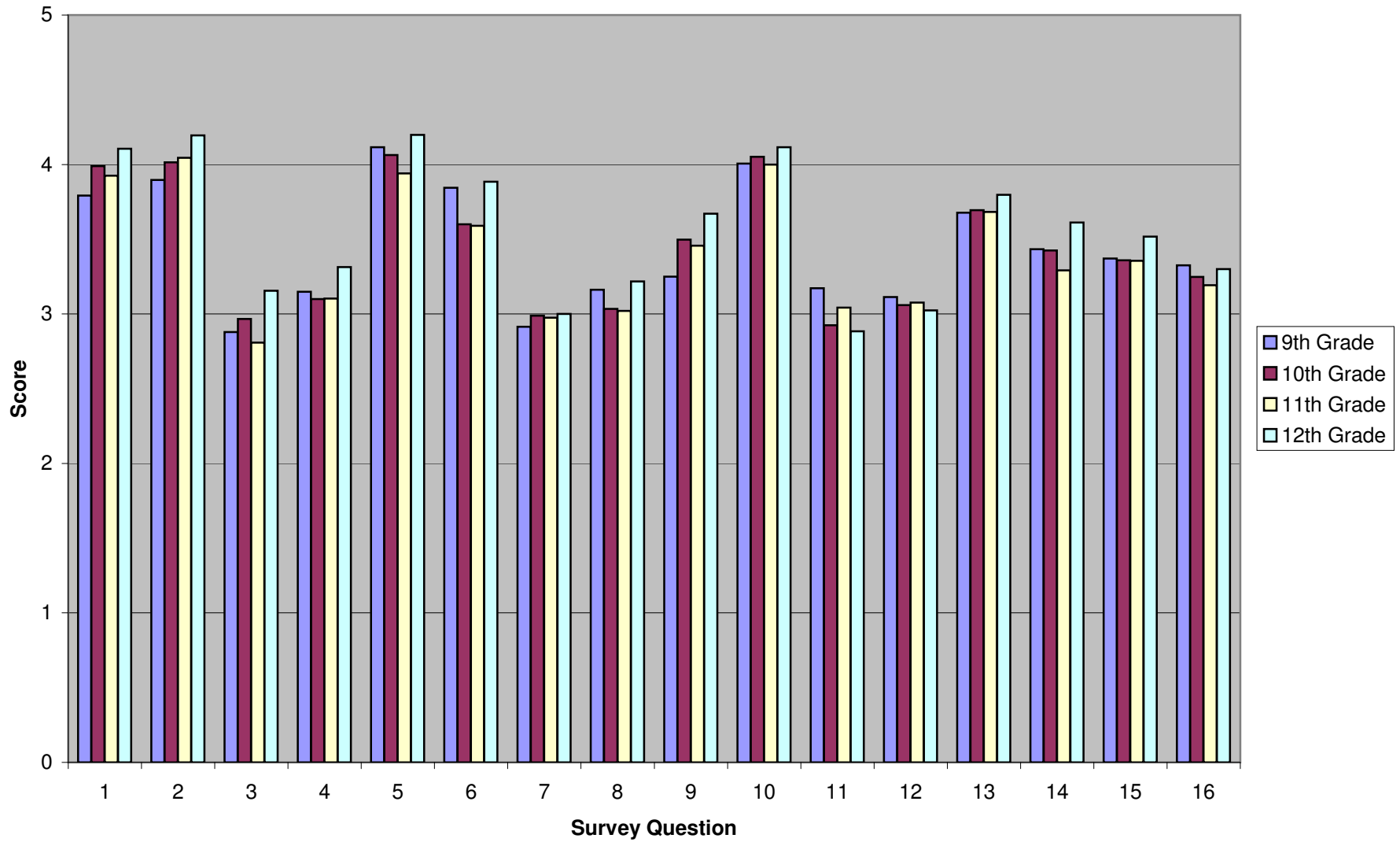

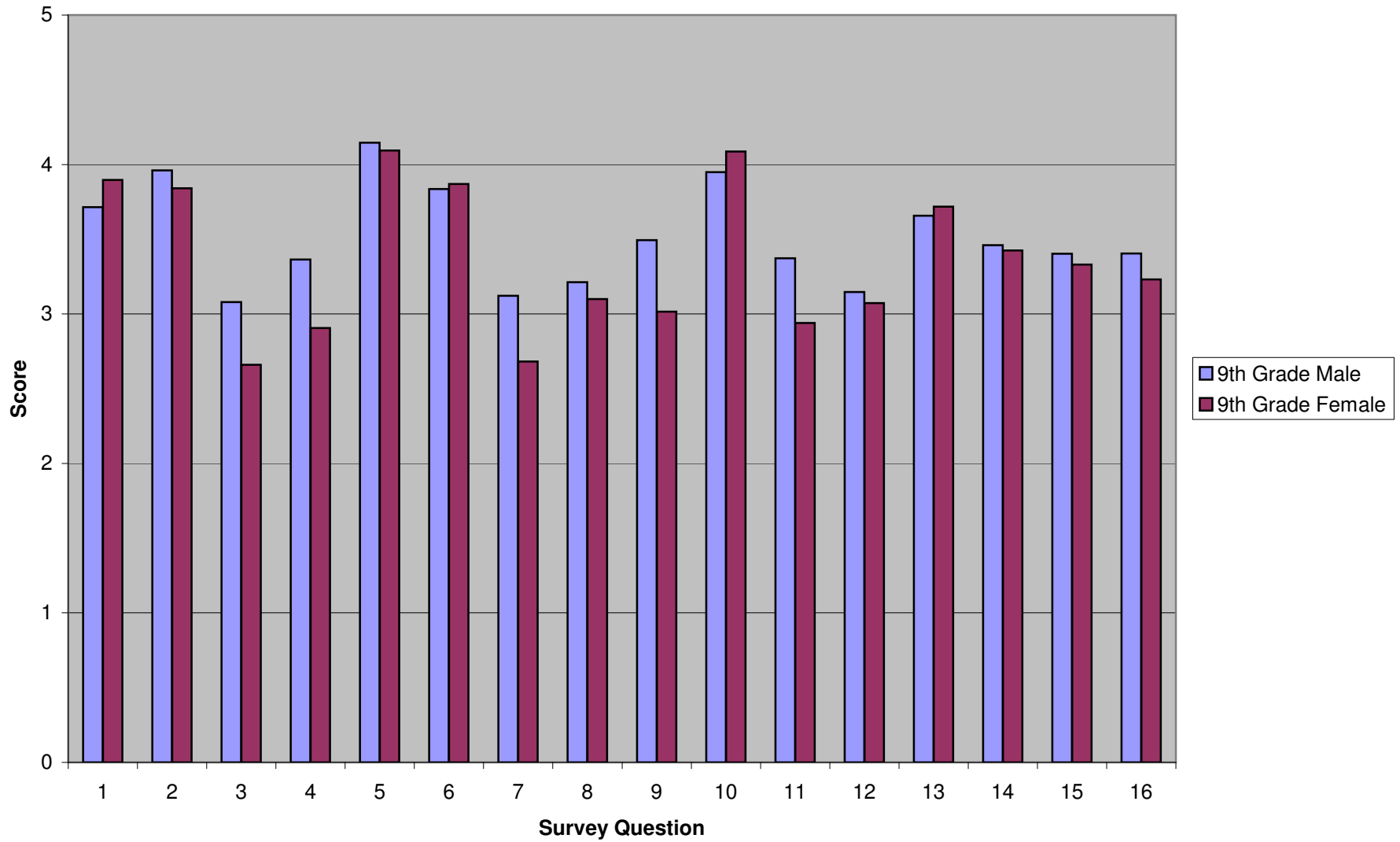

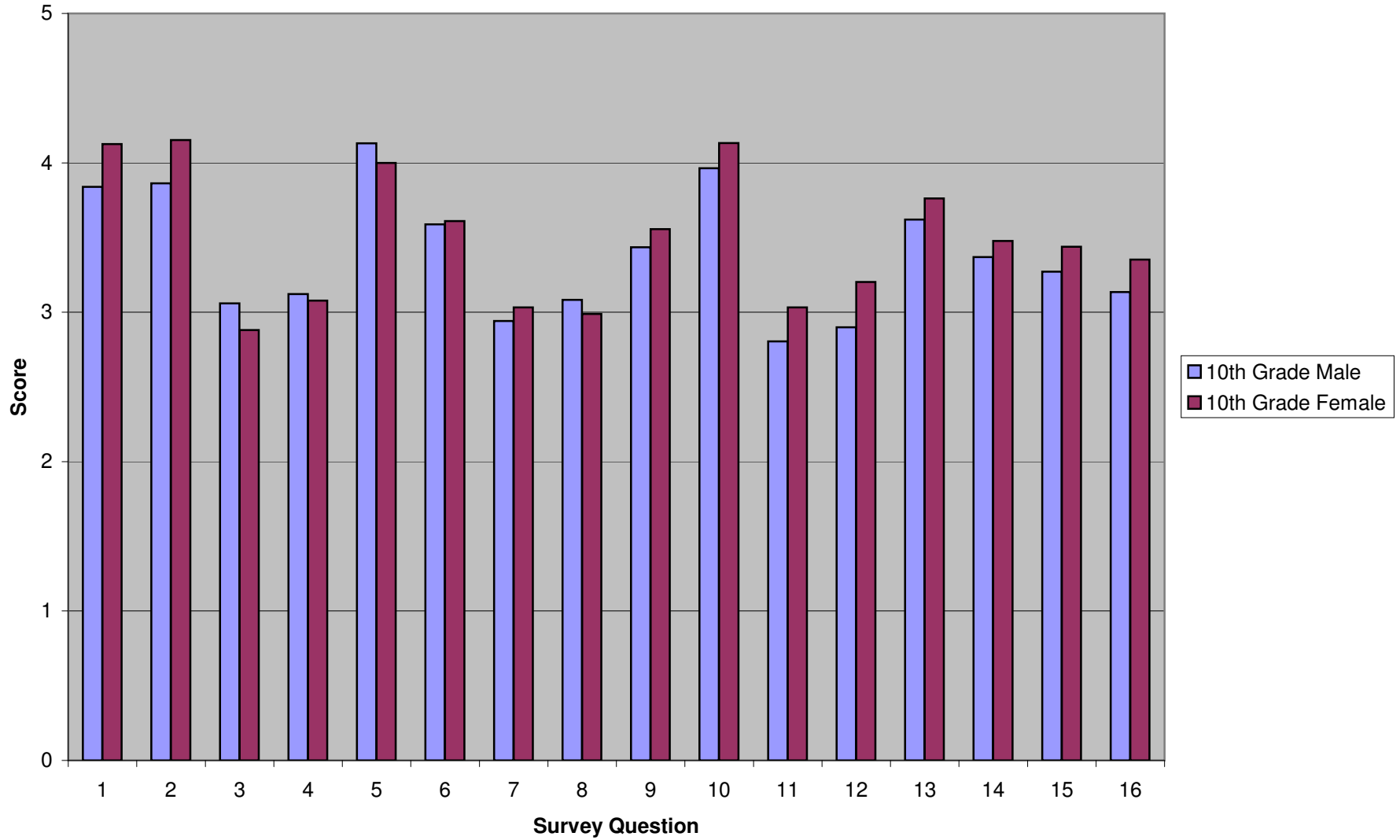

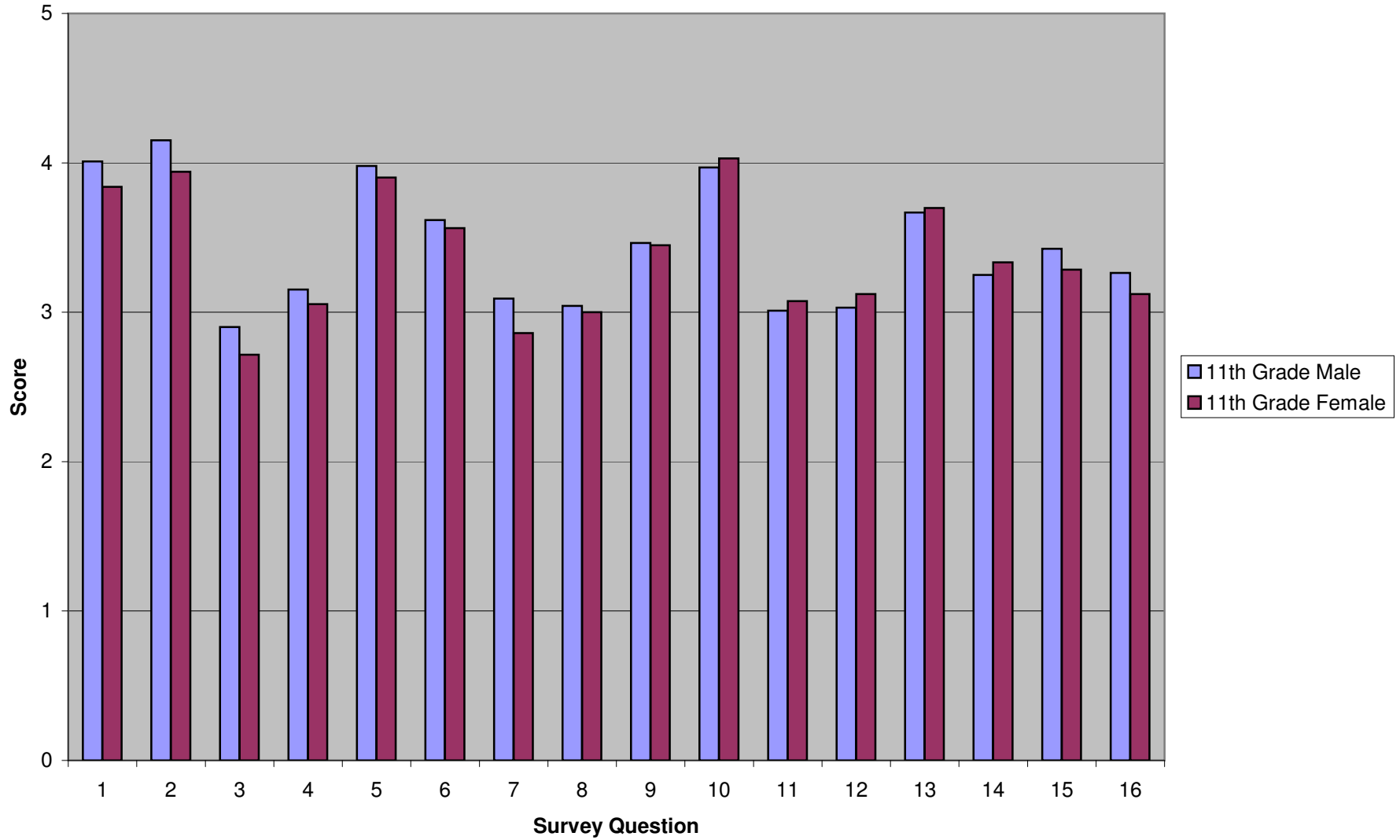
9th Grade Citizenship Survey Males vs Females
