Specifically regarding the Comet House.

Remain in Closed Session pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 19.85(1)(c), Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. Specifically to review the District Administrator's evaluation.
