Working at Waupaca High School is an easy choice. There are few places in Wisconsin as beautiful as Waupaca, and the Waupaca High School Facility is an educational gem of Central Wisconsin. In addition to WHS's

Main Street charm, the high school is also proud of:

- 1:1 technology with Chromebooks
- PBIS Level I & II implementation, see QR code at right.
- Average years of teacher experience: 21.5
- Student-to-teacher ratio 14.6 to 1 in 2016-17.
- In 2016-17, nearly \$275,000 in local scholarship dollars were awarded to WHS students; \$838,000 was awarded overall.



- AP classes: 16; Dual Credit courses with local universities: 4.
- During the 17-18 school year, 69% of seniors and 25% of juniors will take college-level courses.
- Proactively connecting academics with careers through the Waupaca Works Center, Youth Apprenticeships, Comet Manufacturing, onsite CNA and CDL opportunities, and child care certification.

The School District of Waupaca offers:

- Financial stability. There have been no referendums to support operating expenses. In fact, the only public referendum submitted was to support building the high school that opened in 2000. During the summer of 2017, the \$2.5 million in updates required no referendum.
