Why We Need a New Complex

At this time Haberkorn Field serves 140 students/year for football. The proposed cost to make Haberkorn Field safe for spectators is \$730,000 and achieves nothing for actual field improvements.

The new track, soccer, and football facility will serve upwards of 1,000 students/year for soccer, football, track, and physical education classes. The proposed cost of \$2,300,000 would include a new field, track, grandstands, and amenities. As you can see more students would be able to access and utilize this upgraded facility.
