FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

When a vacancy occurs, the remaining members shall fill the vacancy by appointment and the appointee shall hold office until a successor is elected and takes office.

In accordance with Wisconsin Statutes, Sections 120.12(28), and 17.26, when a vacancy occurs in the office of a board member who is in his/her last year of his/her term, or when a vacancy occurs after the Spring election but on or before the last Tuesday in November in the office of a board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the next spring election. When a vacancy occurs between the last Tuesday in November and the next spring election in the office of a board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the 2nd following spring election.

If the remaining members of a school board do not appoint an individual to fill a vacancy within 60 days of the date on which the vacancy first exists, the remaining members of the school board may fill the vacancy in accordance with the school board's policy.

Any person, upon being notified of his or her selection, shall be deemed to have accepted the selection unless within 5 days after notification he or she files with the clerk or director a written refusal to serve.
