BOARD FUNCTIONS

It is usually considered that Boards of Education have the responsibilities for four major functions in their capacity as representatives of the electorate of the School District.

1. Policy-Making

Planning is basic to all activity and policy-making is that planning function which determines what shall be done, establishes procedures for accomplishing the tasks, selects an executive officer and delegates to him/her the placing of plans and policies into operation and provides the financial means for their achievement.

2. Management Rights

The Board reserves the right to manage and operate the schools under the power and duties outlined in the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin

3. Executive

The executive is that function which is concerned with implementation of the policies and plans, keeping the Board of Education and public informed on the operation and management of the schools, and furnishing creative leadership to the Board, staff and profession.

4. Appraisal

Appraisal is that function which attempts through careful examination and study of facts and conditions to determine the efficiency and effectiveness of operation of the general activities, and the worth and value of the results of the instructional program.
