EARLY GRADUATION

The Board of Education recognizes students may qualify for early graduation after seven (7) semesters.

Students applying to graduate after seven (7) semesters must meet the following criteria:

- A. Coursework meets state and local graduation requirements as determined by High School Administration.
- B. Students' immediate future plans include full-time employment, the armed services, and/or enrollment in an accredited technical college, 4-year university.
- C. Student successfully completes (passes) all courses enrolled in during the seventh semester.
- D. During the seventh semester, the students must not be identified as a habitual truant according to the state compulsory school attendance statute 118.15.
- E. Complete procedures for early graduation on or before October 1 of the seventh semester.
Completed application includes signatures by student, parents (if student is less than 18 years old), and high school principal.

Above criteria must be met to the satisfaction of high school administration prior to submission to the District Administrator. Upon District Administrator approval, the application will be forwarded to the Board of Education for final approval.

Honors & Awards

Students graduating early under this policy will not be eligible for Valedictorian or Salutatorian honors or scholarships that require 8 semesters of school attendance.
