YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM

Any 11th or 12th grade student who meets established requirements may enroll in any of the following institutions of higher education for one or more courses:

1. A center or institution within the University of Wisconsin (UW) system;
2. A Wisconsin Technical College; or
3. A participating private, nonprofit institution of higher education located in Wisconsin.

When such course(s) is taken for high school credit, the Board of Education may pay the costs for such course if it is not comparable to one offered in the District and the students may pay the costs if it is comparable. Decisions regarding comparability of courses, satisfaction of high school graduation requirements and the number of high school credits to be awarded shall be recommended by the High School Principal and/or his/her designee and approved by the District Administrator or designee, in accordance with state law and approved policy. If a student is not satisfied with this decision, he/she may appeal to the School Board and then the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Students shall be informed about youth options in accordance with state law.
