FULL-TIME STUDENTS

Elementary students in grade 1-5 shall be considered full-time students at their assigned school when scheduled to be in attendance during the hours instructional classes are conducted for their grades as determined by the administration and approved by the Board.

Students in grade 6-12 shall be considered full-time students when they carry at least the minimum number of credits required by the school they attend as determined by the administration and approved by the Board.

The following are exceptions to the above, and students attending school under these exceptions are considered full-time students because of the nature of the programs and the circumstances involved:

1. Students who are placed in a Youth Home and who attend classes as scheduled at the Youth Home;
2. Students who are in the School Age Parents Program and who attend classes as scheduled for the program;
3. Students who are assigned less than a minimum class load by an IEP Team decision, with parent or guardian approval, because of their disability;
4. Students who are on a Work Experience Program;
5. Students who are receiving Homebound Instruction as approved by parent or guardian and a licensed physician;
6. Students who have other disabilities or who are assigned a program determined by the administration, with parent or guardian approval, to be beneficial to the educational progress of the students; and
7. Students who have been identified as at risk and recommended for an alternative program with parent/guardian approval.

The building principal is responsible to see that adequate and proper records are kept to identify the full-time status of students.
