ENTRANCE AGE - RULE 1

In accordance with Wis. Statutes, Section 115.28(8), the following procedures are established for early admission to kindergarten:

1. A written request by the parent to the District Administrator shall be made on or before May 20th preceding the fall school opening. The District Administrator shall review requests submitted after May 20th and consider extenuating circumstances, such as moving into the district after May 20th as valid reason(s) for missing the deadline.
2. An evaluation or evaluations, without cost to the parent, will be conducted and shall consider the child's strong potential for success and ability to cope with the school environment. Such evaluations may involve a school psychologist and other personnel selected by the District Administrator.
3. The Board of Education shall decide, based on the results of the evaluation(s) of the child and the recommendation of Administration, the appropriateness of early entrance.
4. Following the decision of the Board, the parents will be notified of the decision to place or not place the child in school.
