STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The Board of Education feels it is important in operating a school system to be concerned with the total operation involving varying needs, abilities and desires of all those concerned with the educational process. Individual rules cannot be established for each person involved in the educational process and it becomes necessary to establish rules and regulations for the operation of the schools within the District.

Failure to abide by reasonably established policies, rules and regulations make it mandatory that the administration be authorized to remove non-complying students from the school premise or property after proper notification procedures, through a process known as suspension.

In addition, the administration is authorized to recommend to the Board of Education, after proper notification, permanent removal of students from school through the process known as expulsion.

The Board of Education charges the school administration with developing reasonable regulations and rules which are necessary for the orderly operation of the schools in the School District of Waupaca. The Board will annually approve rules contained in Student Handbooks.
