USE OF PRIVATE VEHICLES TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS

- A. The alternate vehicle must be insured by a policy providing property damage coverage with a limit of not less than \$25,000 and bodily injury liability coverage limits of not less than \$50,000 for each person, a total limit of not less than \$100,000 for each accident.
- B. The motor vehicle shall be inspected annually for compliance with the requirements of S.110.075. The owner of the vehicle is responsible for getting an annual inspection prior to transportation of students.
- C. The vehicle inspector for the district is the head transportation mechanic at the District bus garage.
- D. The driver (operator) shall possess a valid Wisconsin operator's license.
- E. The driver shall be at least 18 years of age.
- F. The driver shall have sufficient use of both hands and the foot normally employed to operate the foot brake and foot accelerator.
- G. The driver shall submit at least once every 2 years to the school medical opinion on such form as the school may prescribe that the operator is not afflicted with or suffering from any mental or physical disability or disease such as to prevent the operator from exercising reasonable control over a motor vehicle. The examination report prescribed in S. 118.25(2) and (4) will be used to satisfy this requirement.
- H. The driver may not be a person convicted of reckless driving under S.346.62, operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant or of a controlled substance under S. 346.63(1), or any of the offenses enumerated under S. 343.31(1) or (2), within a 3 year period. Upon request of the operator or the school, the department shall certify whether the operator meets this requirement.
