2. Provides direct instruction to students related to academic, social and/or work experience skills;
3. Consults and serves as resource to parents, staff, other agency staff, and community business;
4. Monitors students' progress as appropriate;
5. Develops and maintains positive relationships with community businesses;
6. Supervises students placed in work experience situations;
7. Consults with business owners/operators relating to the performance of students;
8. Consults with Alternative Program Committee regarding the Alternative Program, students entering or leaving the program, or other aspects as needed;
9. Attends staff meetings and serves on staff committees as required;
10. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities within the overall scope of the position which the supervisor may assign.
