JOB GOAL: To assist students, parents and staff in developing their skills to the fullest in order to make education a meaningful and valuable experience for the students of the Waupaca School District.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Acts as designee of Director of Exceptional Education and chairs M-Team, Individual Educational Program, and STAR meetings;
2. Completes appropriate forms and paperwork related to M-Team, Individual Educational Programs, and STAR meetings;
3. Evaluates students referred for suspected Exceptional Educational Needs, and Non EEN when appropriate, and interprets evaluation results for staff and parents;
4. Makes recommendations for corrective procedures on referred students;
5. Confers with teachers and parents regarding students when necessary;
6. Conducts individual, group, or facilitative therapy for children whose diagnosed problems would benefit from such therapy;
7. Serves as consultant on mental health topics for teachers and parents;
8. Cooperates with personnel from Department of Human Services and other community agencies related to school psychological services;
9. Attends staff, professional, and interagency meetings;
10. Assists with inservice training of school personnel and parents;
11. Keeps abreast of new developments related to therapy, tests, laws and regulations;
12. Serves as consultant to district on matters relating to district-wide intelligence, achievement, of psychological testing;
13. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities within the overall scope of the position which the supervisor may assign.
