

POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES April 27, 2022 – 5:30 p.m. Waupaca High School Community Room and <u>Live Stream</u>

Welcome and Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairperson Patrick Phair at 5:30 p.m.

Roll Call:

Present in the WHS Community Room: All members of the Committee were present (Chairperson Patrick Phair, Steve Klismet, and Mark Polebitski). Additionally, Board members Stephen Johnson, Dale Feldt, Betty Manion, and Ron Brooks were present.

Also Present:

Present in the WHS Community Room: Ron Saari, Sandy Lucas, and Mark Flaten.

Approval of Agenda:

A motion was made by Mark Polebitski and seconded by Steve Klismet to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Review of Board Meeting Norms:

The Board reviewed their collective commitments.

Items Discussed But Not on the Agenda:

Chairperson Patrick Phair reviewed the upcoming events and advised that he will be unavailable for the Policy Committee meeting scheduled for May 16, 2022, as he will be unavailable May 13 through May 25.

New NEOLA Policy 0144.5 Board Member Behavior and Code of Conduct:

Much discussion ensued with both Chairperson Phair and Committee member Mark Polebitski questioning why we need this policy. Committee member Polebitski went on to state that much of it is a duplication of our governance policies which should be written by the School Board, not NEOLA or anyone else, and that he is very opposed to rewriting them in any way. Mr. Saari advised that this policy is in the Bylaws section of our policy collection, and is more detailed than NEOLA Policy 0144.2 Board Member Ethics. Mr. Polebitski was concerned that we shouldn't mix our governance policies with our NEOLA policies so he doesn't want to consider it.

A motion was made by Mark Polebitski and seconded by Patrick Phair to table NEOLA Policy 0144.5 Board Member Behavior and Code of Conduct as presented to possibly be reviewed further at some point in the future. The motion carried on a 2-1 voice vote with Steve Klismet voting no.

Revised NEOLA Policy 2431.02 – Number of Advisors/Coaches Per District Approved Interscholastic Programs:

The Committee liked this new format in that it provides more flexibility for the coaches. A motion was made by Mark Polebitski and seconded by Steve Klismet to move NEOLA Policy

2431.02 – Number of Advisors/Coaches Per District Approved Interscholastic Programs as amended to the full Board for approval and adoption. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

New Policy 7415 Planning for Building and Grounds Construction and Renovation:

Committee Chairperson Phair asked if this policy should come before the Building and Grounds Committee first. Building and Grounds Committee member Dale Feldt advised he is good with it. Mr. Saari advised that Administration drafted this policy, not NEOLA.

A motion was made by Mark Polebitski and seconded by Steve Klismet to move Policy 7415 Planning for Building and Grounds Construction and Renovation as presented to the full Board for approval and adoption. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Review Waupaca Only Policies:

Mr. Saari advised that these are current SDW policies that NEOLA doesn't have.

The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.
