BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

The School Board believes that reflection and evaluation is essential to the continual improvement and success of a school district. The Board self-evaluation process provides an opportunity for the Board to reflect on its performance in relation to stated goals, priorities, and Board governance policies. The process also provides input for establishing any new Board-specific goals.

Therefore, the Board directs the District Administrator to work with the Board President to structure a time and process for the Board to conduct at least an annual self-evaluation to assess the Board's overall functioning, the Board's contributions toward the accomplishment of District goals, and the Board's progress toward the accomplishment of any Board-specific goals that the Board previously established for itself.

The Board may seek the assistance of the District Administrator in identifying standards for assessment and topics for discussion and/or in selecting an evaluation method or instrument that meets its needs. Responsibilities to be evaluated are detailed in the Policy Governance Manual.
