STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

The Board of Education may include a student representative appointed by the district administrator upon consideration of the recommendation of the high school principal.

Student terms will be limited to one year.

Students may not vote on items. Only board members who have taken and filed the official oath of office may hold this power.

Students may not participate in closed session.

Goals:

- 1. Act as liaison between district students and the school board, providing input on educational issues from a student perspective.
- 2. Report academic and extracurricular highlights on behalf of all district schools.

Expectations:

- 1. Attend all school board meetings.
- 2. Attend selected committee meetings.
- 3. Meet with the district administrator on the Friday or Monday prior to all regular board meetings to discuss issues and receive background information and periodically meet with other building or department leaders to discuss agenda items and receive background information.

Candidate requirements:

- 1. Candidates must be enrolled full time at Waupaca High School.
- 2. Candidates must complete an "Application for Student Representative of the Board."
- 3. A minimum of three letters of recommendation from teachers, employers, coaches or other leaders.
- 4. Letter of support from a school counselor verifying their academic standing.
