JOB GOAL: To provide safe and efficient transportation so that students may enjoy

the fullest possible advantage from the District's curriculum and

extracurricular program.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Obeys all traffic laws;

- 2. Observes all mandatory safety regulations for school buses;
- 3. Maintains discipline when students are on the bus;
- 4. Reports undisciplined students according to the approved procedure as stated in the Bus Driver Handbook;
- 5. Keeps assigned bus clean;
- 6. Keeps to an assigned schedule;
- 7. Checks bus before each operation for mechanical defects;
- 8. Notifies the proper authority in case of mechanical failure or lateness;
- 9. Picks up and discharges students only at authorized stops;
- 10. Exercises responsible leadership when on out-of-district school trips;
- 11. Transports only authorized students;
- 12. Reports all accidents and completes required reports;
- 13. Enforces regulations against smoking and eating on the bus;
- 14. Assures that students get on and off the bus in an orderly fashion;
- 15. Provides written records of violations of the student code to the Transportation Supervisor and/or principal;
- 16. The driver shall practice at least twice during the school year the use of the emergency exits;

17. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities within the overall scope of the position which the supervisor may assign.

WORK SCHEDULE:

The work schedule is arranged by the Transportation Supervisor and approved by the Business Manager and the District Administrator.
