

Rotary Youth Short Term Exchange



About the Program

Rotary Short Term Exchange offers opportunities for students to advance their knowledge and world understanding through an exchange with another country. Participants live with host families in their selected country, usually for three to four weeks in the summer. Their family will in turn host a student from that family for three to four weeks.

Objective

To foster world peace, international understanding and good will. The most powerful force in the promotion of international understanding and peace is exposure to different cultures. Rotary promotes youth exchanges to plant these seeds for a lifetime of international understanding.

Eligibility and Requirements

- Any student, age 15-19 of good character
- Curiosity about other cultures, flexibility, and willingness to be an ambassador for the U.S. to another country
- Willingness of family to host in return

Cost

- \$250 Administrative fee, which includes supplemental Life & Medical Insurance required by Rotary
- Airline ticket
- Spending money
- Hosting costs cost of having a guest in your home for 3 to 4 weeks and any excursions or events your family might plan
