Health Insurance Renewal Recommendation:

WCA Group Health Trust and M3 Insurance representatives presented their proposal for the District's health insurance for the 2022-2023 school year. WCA Group Health Trust is part of the United Healthcare Choice Plus Network, with similar deductibles, coinsurance, and out-of-pocket maximums as the current health insurance provider WEA Trust. They will basically rollover the current WEA Trust plan participants into the new WCA Group Health Trust plan. The District is proposing this switch in health insurance carriers as the premiums with WCA will increase approximately 2% over last year versus much higher increases proposed by other health insurance carriers, including WEA Trust.

A motion was made by Betty Manion and seconded by Ron Brooks to accept and approve WCA Group Health Trust's proposal for the 2022-2023 school year and to be the District's health insurance provider, as well as to renew the District's self-funded dental insurance provided by Delta Dental and the District's LTD insurance through The Standard as presented. The motion carried on a 6-0-1 roll call vote with Dale Feldt abstaining

Adjournment:
