Language Arts:

This week we had fun reading Where Are You Mummy, and Crankenstein. In large group we reviewed how to sequence events/characters to help us retell the story; along with identifying the main characters in each story. During our writing time the students are learning how to write a complete sentence. I brought out some super hero capes to help us remember that a sentence needs to start with a capital letter, spaces in between words, and punctuation at the end.

Science:

On Friday we learned many important facts about bats. The students learned some new vocabulary words such as nocturnal, pup (baby bat), and mammal. We did a chart that talked about what bats can do, what they have, and what they are. Over the weekend ask your child what their favorite bat fact was.

Reminder:

Please remember to make sure your child is dressed appropriately for recess. They will need to have a hat, mittens, and a winter jacket. We already had a couple days of boots and snow pants this week. Please practice with your child on how to get all of their gear on so they can do this independently.
