Language Arts:

We had a lot of fun this week comparing and contrasting - The Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The students were able to identify that both stories had the number 3 in it, took place in the woods, and had a character that ran away at the end of the story. We also read books from other authors who wrote different versions of these classic fairy tales. The titles were: Goldi Rocks and the Three Bears, and The Three Ninja Pigs. The students LOVED how the authors of these books took the main idea and just changed it a little to make a new story. Over the weekend ask your child what was their favorite story that they listened to this week?

Our letter this week was - (Aa) and sight word "we". The students did a nice job recognizing that it was a vowel and that it can make 2 sounds. The following are activities that we did throughout the week to help us learn about our letter. First we made a list of /a/ words, practiced writing capital/lower case Aa, and sounded out words that started with /a/. Each student has a slinky to use for "stretchy the snake" when sounding out words in their reading and writing.
